- **Cholera: Total reported: 18034 AWD/suspected cholera has been reported since the beginning of the year to early September 2020, , mostly reported from Ibb , Yreem, As Saddah, Asabrah, Jiblah & Thi Asufal districts, while Hazm Al Uday district was the least reported (2 rounds of OCV has been conducted) with slight increasing trend from the week 33 weeks after raining, affected children (less than 5 yrs. represent 25 % of reported cases,**
- **Deaths reported was 11 cases (CFR=0.06%) (6 Female & 5 Male) from Asaddah 4, Yareem 2 & 1 in Al Makhader, Ibb Hazm Al Udayn & Hubaysh, with 3 lab confirmed cases.**
- **RDT positive 525 & 1012 negative (Positivity rate=34%)**

Other communicable disease reported in Ibb:

- **Surveillance unit reported cluster of measles cases and suspected 5 polio case in As Saddah district last week, in Wadi Hageb**
- **Samples were sent to the Laboratory**
- **Challenge of the HF building, and to use part of the school as HU**
- **UNICEF asked to support in HU support.**
- **UNICEF reported low vaccination coverage however most of HFs are supported**

Response:

COVID-19:

- **COVID-19 cases received in Alsahool Hospital IU while Jiblah has stopped**
- **COVID-19 Triage establishment by health partners**
- **WHO supported NCPHL Ibb with PCR Machine, waiting for setting up, training & reagents**
- **WHO support to IU is continued**
- **Incentive payment to IU staff is discussed with MOPH**
- **SCI support triage in 3HFs in Ibb, including training, PPEs & incentives for staff, facing challenge in conducting the training7 PPEs as MOPH requested for equipment support & GHO has communicated MOPH**

Cholera:

- **GHO received reasonable amount of cholera medications from MOPH, UNICEF (45 HFs were supported) & WHO.**
